Ashok Daya Ram is a Consultant Paediatric and Neonatal Surgeon and the Training Programme Director in Norwich. Being a staunch educationist, he founded and teaches on the SPRINT Education Programme for Paediatric Surgery. He is the director of Advanced Paediatric Life Support courses and faculty for the European Paediatric Life Support course. He is an executive member of the education committee for the European Society of Paediatric Endoscopic Surgeons.

Ravindar Anbarasan is a Consultant Paediatric Surgeon and Urologist at the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital. He co-founded the SPRINT Education Programme for Paediatric Surgery and has been successfully running these high impact courses for a year, attracting paediatric surgical trainees from across the globe. He has received gold medals in general and paediatric surgery along his career path.

Bhaskar Kumar is a Consultant Oesophagogastric Surgeon and Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital. He has authored a leading textbook and website for the FRCS. He is actively involved in helping trainees succeed in the exam.

Jacob Stephenson is the Chief of Surgery at the Royal Air Force base in Lakenheath. He trained at UC Davis and Seattle Children's Hospital, University of Washington and has been a Consultant Paediatric Surgeon for 10 years. He has been the Director of Paediatric Trauma and Operational Medicine at UC Davis, Sacramento, California. He has been on multiple deployments with surgical teams.

Oliver Muensterer is Professor and Chairman of Paediatric Surgery at Dr. von Hauner Children's Hospital of the Ludwig-Maximilians University Munich, Germany. His main research focus is telemedicine and new media in paediatric surgery, malformations and diseases of the paediatric foregut, fetal intervention, and using multiphoton microscopy in the management of paediatric tumors and Hirschsprung disease.

Naved Alizai is Professor of Paediatric Surgery and a barrister. He is the lead clinician for paediatric surgery, urology, GI, cleft lip & palate. His subspeciality is paediatric robotic hepatobiliary surgery and he is based at Leeds General Infirmary, UK. He provides reports for the General Medical Council, NHS resolution and legal firms.

Milind Kulkarni is a Consultant Paediatric Surgeon, Urologist and Associate Medical Director at Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital. He is also the Clinical Subdean and Honorary Lecturer at Norwich Medical School, University of East Anglia. He is the Clinical Lead for surgery in children at the East of England ODN. He has recently been appointed as the Chair of the Specialist Advisory Committee for the Joint Committee for Surgical Training in Paediatric Surgery.

Yogesh Kumar Sarin is Director, Professor and Head of Paediatric Surgery at Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi. He is President Elect of Indian Association of Paediatric Surgeons (IAPS). He is credited to 300 publications in national and international scientific journals, multiple chapters in textbooks and has participated in/ supervised 43 research projects/thesis. He is the force behind and had been editor-in-chief of the e-journal 'Journal of Neonatal Surgery' and a member of editorial boards of two dozen more scientific journals.

Richard England is a Consultant Paediatric Surgeon at the Jenny Lind Children's Hospital, Norwich. His sub-speciality interest is paediatric colorectal disorders and surgery. He helped set up the UK Paediatric Colorectal Group in 2015 and remains an active member. Over the last year he has established a new bowel management service for children with refractory constipation and faecal incontinence from across the East of England.

Ashwin Pimpalwar is Professor of Paediatric Surgery at Marshfield Children's Hospital at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA. He has won the Fulbright & Jaworski L. L. P. Faculty Excellence Award for Teaching and Evaluation at Baylor College of Medicine, Houston, Texas. He is a member of the Academy of Distinguished Educators (Academy) Baylor college of Medicine, Houston, Texas.
