Laparoscopy

- 1 Diagnostic laparoscopy for abdominal pathology, undescended 4
- 2 Laparoscopic appendicectomy 4

Neonatal Surgery

- 1 Repair of oesophageal atresia 4
- 2 Repair of diaphragmatic hernia/eventration 4
- 3 Application of Gastroschisis silo (preformed; handsewn)
- 4 Repair of abdominal wall defects (gastroschisis, exomphalos) 4
- 5 Surgery to correct malrotation/duodenal atresia 4
- 6 Neonatal gastrostomy formation
- 7 Surgery for small intestinal pathology (NNEC, creation and closure) 4
- 8 Closure of stoma
- 9 Neonatal colorectal surgery (NNEC, colonic atresia, colostomy)/ 4
